

# CALICO Studio Mobile App User Manual (Android & iOS)

## S Overview

CALICO Studio Mobile is a remote control application for the CALICO PRO video processor, designed for anyone who needs easy, flexible control from their mobile device. Whether you are managing a live event or operating the system day-to-day, the app provides smooth, reliable control in a user-friendly interface.

#### Key Features:

- Switch a window source instantly.
- Fire presets for quick adjustments.
- Change and mute audio levels by canvas.
- · Add and manage CALICO devices effortlessly.
- Optimized for responsive and intuitive use.

## Installation Guide

#### For iOS Devices:

- 1. Open the App Store.
- 2. Search for CALICO Studio Mobile.
- 3. Tap "Get" to install.
- 4. Open the app and grant any requested permissions.

#### For Android Devices:

- 1. Open the Google Play Store.
- 2. Search for CALICO Studio Mobile.
- 3. Tap "Install".
- 4. Open the app and allow necessary permissions.

- 1. Launch the App.
- 2. Add your device using device settings and credentials.
- 3. Connect to CALICO PRO. Ensure your mobile device and CALICO PRO are on the same local network.
- 4. Access CALICO PRO securely via HTTPS (e.g., https://calico-pro.local) in the app or browser to ensure encrypted communication.






# Feature Guide

## Changing the Window Source

This feature allows you to choose which video source is displayed in any specific window. Steps:

- 1. Connect to CALICO PRO and go to Windows Tab.
- 2. Tap on the window you want to edit.
- 3. A list of available input sources appears, showing the names assigned (Example: "Camera" or "Media Player.)
- 4. Tap the desired source.
- 5. The new source will display live in the selected window.



## Recalling Presets

Presets are setups for window layouts and sources that have been configured in CALICO Studio. The device must first be set up using CALICO Studio before it can be controlled with the mobile app.

#### Steps:


- 1. Open the Presets Tab.
- 2. Select a preset (e.g., "Full Screen," "Quad View").
- 3. Layout and source changes are applied immediately.



### Adjusting Canvas Audio

This feature lets you control audio levels for each canvas. Steps:

- 1. Go to the Canvas Tab.
- 2. Select the canvas. (Each canvas has a single audio output.)
- 3. Adjust volume with the slider.
- 4. Use Mute/Unmute to toggle sound output.



# Tips & Troubleshooting

- Ensure Wi-Fi/network connectivity between device and CALICO PRO.
- Update the app regularly for new features and bug fixes.
- Restart both mobile device and CALICO unit if connection fails.
- Use clear preset names for quick recall during live operation.
